

PATIENT RELATIONS ENHANCEMENT PROCESS

Welcome to the Cornwall Community Hospital. Our Patient Relations Services seeks to facilitate the investigation and resolution of patient, family and visitor issues, concerns and complaints. Our services are part of the broader strategic priority effort across CCH to continuously improve the patient experience.

I'm afraid that if i complain, things will get worse for me and/or my relative. What should I do first if I have a problem or a concern?

Please be assured that raising a concern will not negatively affect your care (or a loved one's care) in any way. Please follow these steps:

STEP 1

Talk with a member of the health care team

- When you or your family have a concern, please share these concerns as soon as possible. Feel free to speak with any member of the health care team including the Charge Nurse, Social Worker or the Spiritual Care Coordinator. They will listen and respond to your concerns.

STEP 2

Ask to speak with the Manager of the department (contact information on bedside whiteboard during your stay, where applicable)

- If concerns are not resolved to your satisfaction, ask to speak with the Manager of the area in which you stayed during the weekdays or the After-Hours Manager (ext. 3450) during the evening, weekends or holidays.
