The social worker will provide brief clinical services to high risk youth and triage to appropriate services. The social worker will be involved in the implementation of an ED clinical pathway and virtual ED protocol between CCH and CHEO. The social worker will participate as a member of the situation table to coordinate planning for youth presenting with elevated risk factors. The social worker will provide services to clients of the francophone children's mental health agency.
