The successful candidate will preferably possess a Master's degree in Computer Science, Healthcare Administration or Clinical Informatics. Alternatively a Bachelor of Computer Science with commensurate experience and professional development to demonstrate progressive growth in responsibilities.

Previous experience in leading a team in a health care setting; experience with a hospital EHR implementation; CERNER system knowledge/experience preferred.
