JOB TITLE: Nurse Practitioner (**Full-Time**)

Function Summary:

Reporting to the Director, Community Addiction and Mental Health (A&MH) Services the Nurse Practitioner (NP) works collaboratively with the Directors, Managers and health care professionals from across the hospital to assist in the provision of care for clients who are experiencing addiction and/or mental health issues. The NP coordinates client care to facilitate continuity of care for addiction and mental health clients by working collaboratively with our interdisciplinary teams to assess, plan, implement, and evaluate clinical interventions. The incumbent acts as a liaison and consultant to other health care providers and regional partners regarding patient care and health services within the LHIN. She/he provides leadership in the transfer of knowledge into practice in nursing and related fields appropriate to the clinical focus.

Required:

- Holds current Certificate of Competence from the College of Nurses of Ontario in the extended class
- Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing from a recognized University
- A minimum of three years of experience in working with clients who are experiencing addiction/mental health issues
- Ability to apply critical thinking to patient care
- Demonstrated knowledge and understanding of legal and ethical issues
- Excellent organizational, interpersonal, problem solving and decision making
- Demonstrated leadership ability, teaching and consulting skills
- Excellent writing and publication skills
- Clinical expertise related to patient care and administrative, educational and research matters
- Strong clinical assessment skills, in particular in the area of gerontology and respiratory/heart function
- Advanced knowledge of the consultation process as they relate to individuals, groups and/or systems
- Knowledge of the regional health care system in the area of the discipline/specialty
- Knowledge of computers including MS Office (e.g. Word, PowerPoint, Access, Excel, statistical programs, graphics packages)
- Proven ability in working effectively with all members of health care team
- Demonstrated regular, punctual attendance
